INTRODUCING THE 2024 SENIOR CLASS ... KATELYN CRUZE

Katelyn Cruze .. this is a tough sendoff to write because I feel like we should have so much more time with you. From missing a semester, to missing a season, to most improved, to captain and all things in-between ... I will always value our moments and time together. You are tenacious, you are driven, you are emphatic, you are a great teammate & leader, you are a great student, you have been everything we could ask for throughout your four years with us here on and off the floor.

With four games to go in her senior season ... Katelyn currently has played a total of 73 games and 1,300 minutes in a Cardinal uniform, scoring 373 points, grabbing 333 rebounds and holds a 54% field goal percentage. That FG% is currently sixth all-time in program history. With all of the outstanding players that have competed in this uniform, that is no small feat — to be Top 6 in a career category. Katelyn has started a total of 57 games, including 49 games in a row. Katelyn has gone toe-to-toe with some outstanding post players in the MIAC over those 73 games, and will be remembered for her physicality and intensity inside... along with the occasional side eye!

Katelyn also holds a 3.74 cumulative GPA going into her last semester as a secondary education & history major. This major can be extremely time-consuming, especially going into her senior year, as she was away from campus completing her student-teaching. For the first semester, she would be in a classroom teaching all day, then have class at Saint Mary's, and then come to evening basketball practice/games, before completing lesson planning & assignments — all to start the process over again the next day. I have tremendous respect and admiration for Katelyn's being able to be successful in all these areas. It is another testament to her drive and motivation to be at her best. As a student-athlete Katelyn also was named Academic All-MIAC & CSC Academic All-District in the 2022-2023 season.



Katelyn will be missed on and off the floor in our program. I am so excited for Katelyn's next chapter, I have been blessed to be a part of her journey at Saint Mary's and am very thankful for that. You are going to make an outstanding educator and leader of young people. I hope that you continue to share your love for the game of basketball with the next generation of our sport!
